
# APHIS – Animal Care

- Establishes standards of humane animal care and treatment. Monitors and achieves compliance through inspections, education, and cooperative efforts.
  - Animal Welfare Act
    - Animal Exhibitors
    - Dealers
    - Transporters

  - Horse Protection Act
    - Tennessee Walking Horses
    - Racking Horses





# APHIS – Biotechnology Regulatory Services



- Regulates the movement, importation, and field testing of genetically engineered plants and microorganisms
  - Plant Protection Act
  - Agriculture Bioterrorism Act



# APHIS – Veterinary Services



- Prevents, controls, and eliminates animal diseases. Monitors and promotes animal health and productivity
  - Animal Health Protection Act
  - Virus Serum Toxin Act
  - Swine Health Protection Act
  - Agriculture Bioterrorism Protection Act
  - Commercial Transportation of Equine for Slaughter Act



# APHIS – Plant Protection and Quarantine



- Safeguards agriculture and natural resources from the risks associated with the entry, establishment, or spread of animal and plant pests and noxious weeds
  - Plant Protection Act
  - Federal Seed Act
  - Endangered Species Act
  - Honey Bee Act
  - Agriculture Bioterrorism Protection Act




